Nowadays companies don't compete rather supply chain competes. Bangladesh has become one of the most important global suppliers of the world. In the ready-made garment (RMG) sector, Bangladesh is the second largest exporter in the world after China. Bangladesh earned \$55.55 billion in export earnings in fiscal year 2022-23, seeing a narrow growth of 6.67% year-on-year growth on the backs of the apparel sector, according to recent data by the Export Promotion Bureau (EPB). The country's export earnings crossed the milestone of \$50 billion for the second consecutive fiscal year. It previously earned \$52.08 billion from export earnings in FY22.

However, to sustain such a growth rate in the future, Bangladesh needs to compete with other emerging countries like Vietnam, Myanmar, and the Philippines etc. Knowledge-based manpower can be a good resource to sustain those achievements.
